
Jagran Lakecity University is a world-class teaching and research institution situated in the heart of one of India's most liveable cities, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.

Jagran Lakecity University Bhopal (JLU) is a private university established under Section 2(f) of UGC Act 1956 and is based out of Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.

JLU is one of the fastest growing and one of the most awarded universities of Central India having practice based pedagogy at its core. Currently the University is offering 56 degree programmes to more than 2500 students from 8 countries and 27 states of India. The University has 27 partnerships with top industries and international universities ensuring the students get great exposure both nationally and internationally. JLU Bhopal is the only university from Central India to be a part of three Erasmus+ projects funded by the European Union Commission and is also currently the Country Chair for Association of Universities of Asia Pacific (AUAP).

The University has been bestowed with several prestigious awards, such as 'University of the Year' by Government of Madhya Pradesh for consecutive four years in 2015, 2016 2017 and 2018 and was recognized as a Global League Institution in 2015 at the House of Commons, London, UK. JLU Bhopal has been ranked "No. 1 Private University in Madhya Pradesh" in the year 2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019 by several leading publications.

The School's existing and planned faculty members represent diverse disciplines and research interests. They aim to influence policy dialogue and public opinion through publications, public lectures and writing in the media. They also hold memberships in many influential policy-related committees in India and abroad. The members regularly publish research papers on a variety of issues in peer-reviewed journals.

- ***Intergovernmental Relations, Governance and Partnerships*** – Multi-level governance; metropolitan reforms and metropolitan governance; rescaling the state; public-private partnerships; institutional restructuring; strategic collaboration, cross-border alliances and growth coalitions.
- ***Urban Studies, Housing Studies and Urban Planning*** – New urban trends and challenges arising from contemporary patterns of urbanization, including the implications for urban theory, urban policy, urban politics, urban marginality and urban political economy.
- ***Organizational Ethics and the Public Sector*** – Governance and oversight; ethical theorizing; and the public sector and codes of conduct.



BA (Hons) Public Policy & Administration (3 years)



The programme establishes academic rigour while enabling participants to learn about policy & administration in their practical application. Career pathways include graduates to work in prestigious agencies and firms in the public, private, and nonprofit sectors, as well as their own start-ups and social enterprises. The programme also helps students to aim for other civil and public services.

Through the programme students develop the knowledge and skills needed to be public administration professionals in the public, non-profit or private sectors, understand how governments make decisions, learn how to develop, analyze and manage the policies and programs that shape our lives, gain knowledge and skills required to evaluate public policies, programs and public services to ensure citizens' needs are met, and explore the latest developments, issues and initiatives in the public sector.

Designed to provide a balance between applied and theoretical learning, the course will enable you to examine policy from multiple perspectives. MA Public Policy & International Affairs (2 years)



The Master of Arts in Public Policy & International Affairs is a 2-year programme, which emphasizes a comparative approach to domestic politics and institutions on one hand, as it prepares students to address major national policy issues and manage organizations in India. On the other hand, it also prepares students to address major international issues as experts and leaders in governments and organizations around the world.

Students develop the qualitative and quantitative analytical skills, in depth knowledge of a policy concentration and practice skills to address real world challenges in policy and administration. They also acquire insightful knowledge, practical skills and real-world experience to address the big issues of international affairs.

The curriculum integrates extensive experiential learning, projects, internships and Capstone Workshop program in the field*.

*A Capstone Workshop is a live consulting project with an external agency outside of JLU. Each workshop partners a team of about 6-8 students with a faculty advisor. The goal is to provide agency/ organization with innovative analysis and practical recommendations, while JSPP & IA students gain experience by working on a real-world problem. This is a core requirement for Master of Arts in Public Policy & International Affairs, that gives students an opportunity to put learning into practice.

PhD Programmes

Along with a range of graduate & post graduate studies, the School also proposes to offer researchers and practitioners, the PhD programme in the areas of public administration and policy, social research, international affairs, stakeholder engagement and leadership and various other concentration tracks.

It looks at the spatial dynamics of urbanization, the influence of global or indigenous capital, the nature of jobs and the standard of living it creates, as well as the inequality within it. Public policies play a central role in determining the shape and nature of urbanization
