## Ph.D Programme

---

Jagran Lakecity University is a research oriented University that offers a robust and high quality Ph.D programme. At JLU we are committed to excellence in research that contributes to the well-being of the society and addresses contemporary challenges. The University has a doctoral programme in the fields of Law, Media and Communication, Management, Commerce & Economics, Humanities & Arts, Hospitality and Tourism, and Engineering and Technology. We have created a research culture to promote quality research nurtured by researchers with a creditable track record .

The University determines the number of doctoral students that can be admitted to the programme based on the number of available research Supervisors. The University aims to maintain the highest research standards, and with this goal in mind, and as per the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016, JLU follows specific criteria for selection of Ph.D students. The University has a well-designed course work schedule followed by continuous follow up and review of progress during the different phases of data collection, data analysis and thesis writing.

## Ph.D Research Disciplines

---

Following academic disciplines have been approved for the doctoral research programme - Law, Media & Communication, Management, Commerce & Economics, Humanities & Arts, Hospitality & Tourism, and Engineering & Technology.

## Ph.D Programme Eligibility

---

- The minimum eligibility for admission to Ph.D Programme shall be:
  - Postgraduation (Master's degree) in the specified/related discipline from any recognized University with at least 55% Marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree with equivalent grade from a foreign educational Institution as may be approved by AIU
  - A pass in the Entrance Test and Interview conducted . Those students who have qualified UGC-NET (including JRF)/ UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/ SLET/ GATE shall not have to write the written test but are required to attend the interview.

- Professional qualification in Chartered Accountancy /Cost Accountancy/ Company Secretary as awarded by the respective Statutory Institutes of India will be considered as equivalent to Master Degree for the purpose of enrolment for Ph.D in Commerce, Management and/or related disciplines as approved by the Regulatory Authority concerned.
- No candidate will ordinarily be permitted for admission to Ph.D programme in a Subject/Faculty different from the one in which the candidate has obtained the Master Degree. However, permission to pursue in a different Subject/Faculty may be considered by the Doctoral Committee in special cases on the recommendation of the Research Advisory Committee subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.

## Ph.D Admission Procedure

---

- Discipline wise intake for Ph.D programme shall be determined annually by the academic bodies depending on the availability of eligible Research Supervisors duly considering scholar-supervisor ratio and the required academic /physical facilities for research.
- The Application Form for Ph.D shall be filed online through the specified link in the University Website ([www.jlu.edu.in](http://www.jlu.edu.in)) as per the directions given therein and by paying the online prescribed non-refundable Admission Processing Fee.

Soft copy of the Research Proposal duly quoting the Application reference must also be mailed to [research@jlu.edu.in](mailto:research@jlu.edu.in).

Only the Candidates who meet eligibility criteria and whose Application is complete in all aspects shall be provided with the Admit Card to appear for the JLURET.

The admission process will consist of:

- Entrance Test for 100 Marks of two hours duration followed by a personal interview. The syllabus for the entrance test will cover 40 percent relating to General Research Methodology and 40 percent on specific Discipline and 20 percent on Critical Analysis. Candidates must score at least 50% in the Entrance Test.
- The Personal Interview will be organised by the Office of Admissions on specified date/time (generally on the same date of Entrance Test) by constituting an Interview Board of three members consisting of the Head of the Department concerned or a Senior Professor/Associate Professor from the Department, a Supervisor/ Expert in the field of Research and a chosen independent member from the panel of specific discipline experts recommended by the Research Cell/ Department concerned.

- Based on the Eligibility Norms of the JLURET score of 70% and Personal Interview score of 30% a total Score of 100 Points (as per specified Format), the Examination Team will prepare a discipline wise rank list of selected candidates for admission who have secured a total Score of at least 50 Points and forward the same to the Research Cell.
- On the basis of the result, a Provisional Admission Letter will be provided to the successful admitted candidates for the Ph.D Programme.

## Ph.D Coursework

---

The Ph.D coursework is conducted by the University and is divided into two terms. A minimum of 85 percent attendance is a requirement for completing the coursework. Any missed class must be compensated for by the scholar in consultation with the course instructor. A transcript with grades will be issued by the Controller of Examinations on successful completion of the coursework. After completion of Coursework Term I and II, the scholar is eligible to proceed for the RDC (Research Doctoral Committee).

## Ph.D Stipend for Doctoral Fellows and Teaching Assistants

---

A select number of Ph.D Scholars will be offered a Ph.D Stipend and designated as Doctoral Fellows and Teaching Assistants. They would be attached to the School at which they are pursuing their Ph.D and be required to undertake teaching responsibilities in the Department, besides undertaking their research work. This Ph.D Stipend will be for a three year duration extendable by another one year on demonstrating satisfactory performance.

## Fee structure
